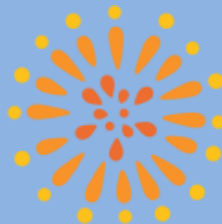

Our Church's Heritage & History

Write the vision make it plain



After seeking the Lord in prayer, our founding Pastor Elder Prince King along with His wife Evangelist Wenderlee King and daughter Sister Octavia King organized the Children's Bread Ministries In July



2006 Children's Bread Ministries, under the leadership of the Bishop William Grant Bahamas Jurisdictional Prelate of the Church of God In Christ. The Church was officially Commissioned on Sunday 31st December 2006 and had grown to (12) members at that time. Our humble beginnings commenced at the home of our founding Pastor in Price Street Nassau, Village New Providence. Services were held every Sunday at 9:45 A.M. And Divine Service at 11:00 a.m. As time passed the vision placed by God in our Pastor's heart was written on paper and Pastor King began seeking for a building in order for the vision to prosper. In the first week in August 2009 a dedication service was held at Podoleo Street and the name of the Church was change to Children's Bread Apostolic Baptist Church and our Pastor Elder Prince A. King became the first Apostle and Overseer and Asst. Pastor Wenderlee King was ordained as Co- Pastor. The Church Then joined the Morning Star Baptist Association spending two years. At this same time we went under General Overseer Rev. Dr. Stanley G. Ferguson Pastor of The New Free Community Holiness Baptist Church . We have had numerous events such as revivals, spiritual warfare & women's conferences, outreach and Evangelism services on the Englerston Community park, winning souls for Jesus Christ. Each year the Church gives out back to school supplies, door to door or at C.H. Reeves School. Dr. King has a heart for people and over the years would feed the whole Church on some Sundays out of the month. One of the goals of the church is to strengthen the area of distribution of food and clothing to the lessfortunate. We have been worshipping at the C.H. Reeves Junior High School since July 2013. We are presently seeking property for a permanent home. Over these Ten years Dr. King was able to established different Auxiliaries namely the prayer band, Sunday school, youth, living sacrifice fine arts, praise and worship team, the Women's and Men Departments. Apostle and Pastor King have performed (6) ordinations of ministers and (5) deacons and (1) Field Evangelist, (3) Christenings- baptisms, the Church has had (2) weddings & (4) funerals. It is our desire to advance the kingdom of God until his return and to finish strong. Many have come and been set free and moved on. Our first children are now grown. The History of Children's Bread is not yet completed & the future though written by God is yet to be manifested, for this is just the beginning. We look through the eyes of faith and stand alone on the word of God the bible awaiting the manifestations of the promised vision. To God in all things be the glory.
